The Executive Council has decided to extend to members of The Protein Society of Thailand a 50% discount on 2013 Full Membership. The Full Membership standard dues are \$150/\$200 with the dividing line being December 15<sup>th</sup>, 2012. Your members can purchase a Protein Society membership for \$75 on or before 12/15, and for \$100 after that. We have rates for early-career investigators and students, but those are already discounted substantially so any of your members who fall in to those two categories should opt for the appropriate membership level. These would be full memberships, with all benefits and voting rights.
